Maternity roosts

Female bats are beginning to form maternity colonies and are looking for suitable nursery sites, such as buildings, trees or bat boxes.

Preparing for Hibernating

Bats become torpid (sluggish and cold) in November as they drop their body temperature and begin hibernation.

Mating & swarming

Mating occurs through the Autumn and bats can often be seen "swarming" outside the roost.

Bats are hibernating by December to conserve energy in the colder months when insects are hard to find.
