

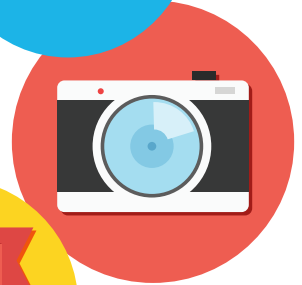
# Activity 3

## Look around your school grounds

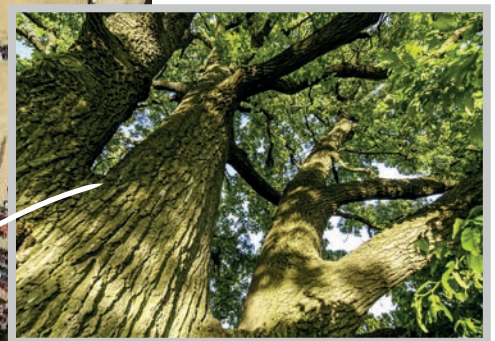
1. Make a map of your school grounds (or use google maps).
